

# BARNSELY BEER FESTIVAL EASTER 2009

## THE BEER ORDER

Updated 8<sup>th</sup> April 2009 at 7.30am

1 ELLAND – PORTER 6.5% International Award Winning Porter based around an original 1872 recipe (hence the name), very dark and rich with a complex bittersweet palate and luscious malt flavours with warming rich port notes that combine into the subtle hoppy finish.

2 ELLAND – BEYOND THE PALE 4.2% Beyond the Pale is a pale golden bitter brewed with a touch of Amber Malt. Pronounced floral hop aroma from the inclusion of North American Cascade hops and a long, dry hoppy finish.

8 BREW COMPANY – FRONTIER IPA 4.7% Our India Pale Ale is light in colour but bursting with flavour. This ale is straw coloured, crisp and dry with a bitter aftertaste - An ale fit for the Empire!

9 BREW COMPANY – SPRING BOCK 3.8% Made from Munich malt this light pale beer is very well balanced and rounded with fruity, floral hops.

10 ULVERSTON- LONESOME PINE 4.2% A pale honey beer with sweet malts, followed by tangy citrus fruits. Refreshing all year round. Pale malt, Cara and Torried wheat, Pure honey, Styrian Goldings and Amarillo hops.

11 ULVERSTON- LAUGHING GRAVY 4% This is a light copper beer with a balance between malt and hops, leaving a thirst quenching after taste. Pale malt, Crystal, Amber, Chocolate, Torried wheat, Amarillo and Golding hops

12 ULVERSTON- ANOTHER FINE MESS 4% A pale full bodied beer with a sweet hoppy aroma. Fruitiness balanced with juicy malts leads to a moreish after taste. Pale malt, Crystal Maize and Barley. Styrian Goldings & Cascade hops.

13 ACORN-BARNSELY BITTER 3.8% Brewed using finest quality Maris Otter malt and English hops. Chestnut in colour, having a Well-rounded, rich flavour, it retains a lasting bitter finish.

17 ACORN-YORKSHIRE PRIDE 3.7% Very pale session bitter, well hopped with Northdown and Cascade hops.

19 ACORN-EGG CRACKER 4.7% Deep copper coloured bitter with hints of chocolate and a rich fruit aroma.

29 HAWKSHEAD RED 4.2% A Red Ale. Bitter-sweet. Malty and spicy, with a long dry finish, using Fuggles as the aroma hop. The red colour comes from Dark Crystal malt.

- 30 HAWKSHEAD LAKELAND GOLD 4.4% A Golden Ale. Hoppy and uncompromisingly bitter with complex fruit flavours from the blending of a modern English hop, First Gold, with the American, Cascade.

- 41 WATERMILL COLLIE WOBBLE 3.7% A pale gold bitter with a slight citrus taste. A good hop and malt balance gives way to a thirst quenching dry finish
- 42 WATERMILL ISLE OF DOGS Golden hoppy and malty
- 43 HAWKSHEAD BITTER 3.7% A pale, hoppy, fruity and bitter session ale, with the distinctive aroma of Slovenian hops.
- 44 HAWKSHEAD BRODIES PRIME 4.9% A Porter -- a dark premium beer with an unusual medley of flavours.

## **CIDERS**

- 1 Gwynt y Ddraig 6.5% Llanwit Fardre, Glamorgan, Dry Cider  
An exceptionally refreshing, well balanced cloudy cider made from local Welsh apples.
- 2 Seidro Sir 7.1% Betws Diserth, Powys, Med-Dry Cider  
Founded in 2001, the first 200 gallons of cider were donated back to the earth.
- 3 Rosie's Triple D 6.6% Llandegla, Denbighshire, Med Cider  
An award-winning cider produced from 100% scratted and pressed apples.
- 4 Springfield Red Dragon 7.0% Llangovan, Gwent, Med Cider  
One of only two ciders awarded 2 Gold Stars in the 2008 Great Taste Awards
- 5 Troggi 7.2% Earlswood, Gwent, Dry Cider  
Non-filtered and oak conditioned whole juice dry cider from local orchards
- 6 Hecks 7.0% Street, Somerset, Medium Dry Cider  
A classic oak-fermented cider using Kingston Black apples.
- 7 Newton Court Cider 7.0% Leominster, Herefordshire, Med Cider  
Made from organically grown fruit from their own orchards. A multi award winner.
- 8 Orchard's 7.0% Brockweir, Gloucestershire, Med-Sweet Cider  
Easy drinking forest cider
- 9 Rathay's Old Goat 7.3% Sutton, St.Nicholas, Herefordshire, Dry Cider  
A slightly hazy with some bite, orchards fertilised by Angora goats on this smallholding.
- 10 Wilkin's 6.0% Mudgley, Somerset Med Cider  
Some raw apple character with a good amount of bite. Very drinkable.
