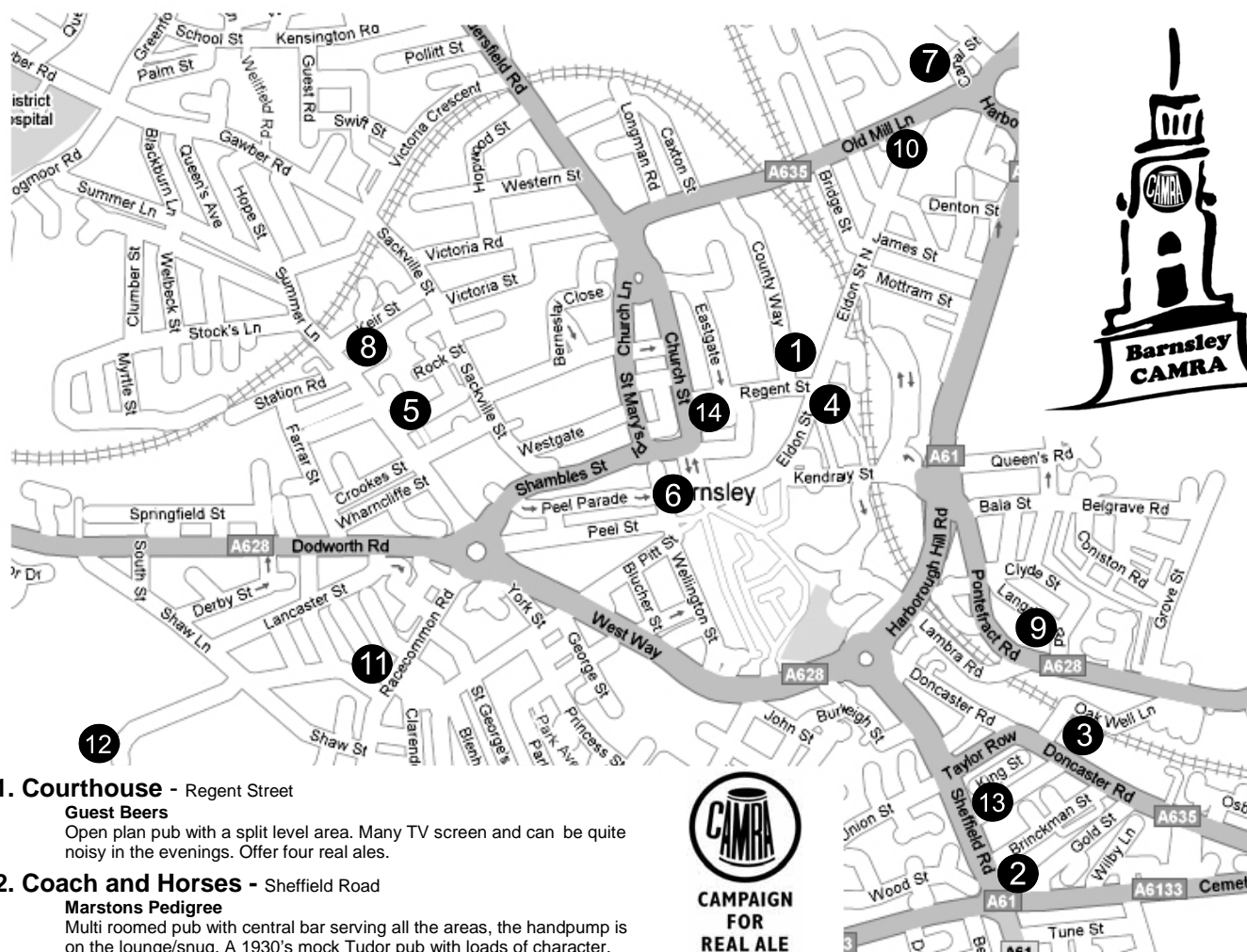


Barnsley Real Ale Outlets

Below is a map that shows all the current real ale outlets in the town. Barnsley is not fortunate like Sheffield or Wakefield to have the large amount of Independent or Free House pubs which offer great value and great real ales. What Barnsley can offer though is a good choice of real ale pubs (which keeps slowly growing) that all serve real ales at their best.

Join CAMRA - Look for the membership forms in the pubs you visit, and in copies of the BAR newsletter.



1. Courthouse - Regent Street

Guest Beers

Open plan pub with a split level area. Many TV screen and can be quite noisy in the evenings. Offer four real ales.

2. Coach and Horses - Sheffield Road

Marstons Pedigree

Multi roomed pub with central bar serving all the areas, the handpump is on the lounge/snug. A 1930's mock Tudor pub with loads of character.

3. Dove Inn - Doncaster Road

Old Mill Bitter, Seasonal Ale

Splendid pub which was re-opened by the Old Mill brewery in 2006. The décor is standard Old Mill style.

4. Gatehouse - Eldon Street

Guest Beers

The pub is situated at the main entrance to the Barnsley Interchange. Bare boarded open plan. Offers five real ales.

5. George and Dragon - Summer Lane

John Smiths Cask and Guest Beers

Popular locals pub, like a village pub in town centre.

6. Joseph Bramah - Market Hill

Guest Beers

Barnsley's Wetherspoons. Large two levelled drinking area with TV's and loud music in the evenings.

7. Keel Inn - Canal Street (nr ASDA)

Guest Beers

Multi roomed pub with a nautical feel. Guest beers are from micro breweries, this is one of Barnsley's rare free houses.

8. Moulders Arms - Summer Street (off Summer Lane)

John Smiths Cask, Guest Beer

A wonderful back street pub where visitors are made welcome.

9. Mount - Pontefract Road

John Smiths Magnet

Popular with home fans on match day, the handpump is in the games room.

10. Prince of Wales - Eldon Street North

Guest Beers

Splendid three roomed pub with friendly licensees. Pool and darts room, lounge and snug like area at the end of the bar.

11. Shaw Inn - Racecommon Road

John Smiths Cask and Guest Beer

Once described as a town centre pub for grown-ups. Large split level pub with games and upstairs function room.

12. Shaw Lane Sports Club - Off Shaw Lane

Guest Beers

Very popular sports club offering up to three ales.

13. Rising Sun - Sheffield Road

John Smiths Cask

Small busy pub with a local feel.

14. White Bear - Church Street

Black Sheep Bitter and Taylor Landlord

A fresh new look to the centre of Barnsley and a welcome addition to the real ale drinking scene. A modern look with high wooden tables, plush snugs and forest tree wall coverings.
